

WASTE AND RESOURCE EFFICIENCY POLICY

Redrow acknowledges that resources used during construction have wide environmental and social impacts, including waste generation. The Group is committed to responsible use of resources, through waste strategies, procedures and procurement.

As a producer of waste, Redrow are required to meet Duty of Care provisions under the Environmental Act 1990. Therefore, we will ensure that:

- All relevant waste legislation and our Health, Safety & Environmental Standards are complied with.
- All staff, suppliers and sub-contractors comply with all relevant legislation relating to the production, handing, disposal and storage of waste.
- Sites and offices have the correct permits or exemptions in place, and that all waste is transported and disposed of by licensed companies only.

Redrow is committed to good practice waste management and minimisation. We aim to:

- Eliminate waste and use the best methods of waste management as detailed in the Waste Hierarchy (prevention, reuse, recycle, recovery and disposal).
- Adopt and embed Circular Economy principals, including a life-cycle approach towards design and specification, to reduce waste generated through design activities.
- Purchase environmentally preferable products and increase the proportion of recycled materials used to build our homes, wherever possible and within budgetary limitations.

To achieve the aims outlined in this policy, we will:

- Collaborate with the supply chain to reduce waste and ensure that our subcontractors manage waste properly and maximise recycling.
- Encourage our sites and offices to segregate and recycle waste on site where practicable.
- Evaluate waste contractors used on sites and work with them to improve performance.
- Ensure all waste contractors comply with Health and Safety and Environmental legislation.
- Collaborate with peers and industry working groups to waste and promote best practice.
- Measure, monitor and report annually on resource efficiency.
- Gather data on the amount of waste produced by our sites and externally verify this data.
- Report our resource efficiency performance in the public domain, including on our website and in the Annual Report.
- Set targets to reduce waste.
- Review our performance and put in place action plans to continually improve our performance.
